## **Sand Ridge Charter School - Sweet Home Charter School - P.I.E. Preschool**

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### **Overview - Operational Blueprint Plans for Reopening**

*This document highlights some of the key changes and operational plans that all P.I.E., Inc. school campuses will implement throughout the 2020-21 school year. Please note, in recognition of feedback received from the entire school community, all efforts will be made to maintain a school environment which is as "normal" as possible for staff and students, while still maintaining compliance with local, state, and federal guidance and regulations for operation.*

### **School Schedule-** Featuring a full-time, on-site, in-person instructional schedule

- Full-day classroom instruction, in-person, every day! *(As permitted based upon the required local and state metrics for school reopening as set by the Governor & ODE guidance)*
- Staggered arrival/dismissal times to maximize the ease of flow in entering/exiting the building and minimize congestion during daily drop off/pick up
- Bus service will not be provided at this time, parents will be responsible for ensuring the on-time transportation of their child to and from school each day.

### **Health & Safety Policy-** Operating in compliance with the policies and guidance from the Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Department of Education

- Updated Communicable Disease Management Plan includes increased time requirements for the length of exclusion from school when a child/staff member is sick in order to maintain health & safety for all
- Sick students will be immediately isolated and required to remain at home until symptom free per exclusion policy guidelines.
- Limited access to the school building – everyone entering the school campus must receive a brief health screening and temperature check.
- All students & staff will wear a facial covering/shield *(as required by the Governor & ODE guidance)*

### **Building Operations-** Small class roster size allows students to remain in a, stable, consistent, cohort group of students and staff members, featuring greater individualized learning interactions

- Scheduled/Assigned Lunch, Recess, bathroom breaks, and PE times based upon classroom cohort
- Meals will be consumed in the classroom with routine hand washing and sanitization protocol followed before meals and throughout the school day
- All shared equipment/building space will be sanitized between uses by the various classroom cohorts to mitigate the spread of germs

### **Instruction-** All instruction will take place in-person. Materials will be made available for students who miss school due to illness.

- Students will remain in their cohort classroom with consistent staff providing instruction for all content. PE, Music, Art, and/or other instruction will be supervised/taught by the classroom teacher and/or eliminated.
- Ample time will be provided for learning- Instructional activities should be completed in class with minimal to no homework in order to minimize the need to transfer items between home and school in order to further mitigate the spread of germs
